
TRUST DEED





- (iii) To propagate, Impart and adopt any audio-visual methods for solving the problems of man or generally mankind without reservation of his status, caste, creed, colour, sex or religion.
- (iv) To promote Arts & Crafts, Culture & Traditions of India through proper channels and procedures of the government
- (v) To aid and establish any institution or adopt means for imparting, promotion of any arts, science or any other field of education, propagate for the removal of any form social evils particularly for the poor and weaker sections of the society in India.
- (vi) To promote literacy, cultural and other social activities by awareness programs, Adult education classes, lectures, essay competition, exhibitions, symposiums, cultural programs, press conferences and seminars.
- (vii) To give stipends, allowance or gratuities, recurring or otherwise, for the maintenance etc. for such time or durations as may deem proper and necessary.

(viii) To arrange and organize various kinds of women and child welfare and other activities or programs on Socio-economic issues like women empowerment etc.

(ix) To organize meetings, seminars, discussions and press conferences, to raise legal demands and fundamental rights provided by The Constitution of India.

(x) To establish or take over hospitals and or conduct medical research.

(xi) To carry out medical research by engaging in the research and development of all fields of medical sciences, and in all therapies of medical treatment, so as to afford medical relief in a better way.

(xii) To provide research facilities for carrying on research, basic and applied, in all systems and disciplines of medical and surgical knowledge, keeping in view the socio-medical and socio-economic needs of the afflicted community.

(xiii) To found, establish or take-over and/or otherwise conduct research institutions in all discipline of medical and surgical knowledge.

(xiv) To encourage and develop biological and pharmacological standardization of indigenous medicinal plants.

(xv) To encourage the discovery of new medical and/or surgical management of diseases and afflictions and to investigate and make known the nature and merits of investigations and findings and research in the said field and to acquire any patent and licences or other protective devices relating to the results of any discovery, investigations, findings or researches and to acquire any processes upon such terms as to manufacture and distribute for charitable purposes of any product developed, discovered or improved.

(xvi) To provide, encourage, initiate or promote facilities for the discovery, improvement or development of new methods of diagnosis, understanding and prevention and treatment of diseases.

(xvii) To establish any home, institution or society for knowledge and for the welfare, maintenance and development of Orphans, Old age

people and other weaker sections of our society and make adequate arrangements and start rehabilitation camps and centres for the destitute and needy people.

(xviii) To establish any institution or society for the welfare of people who suffer out of natural calamities and provide food and shelter to any needy person or persons from time to time.

(xix) To undertake the compilation, printing and publication of:

i. Simple booklets explaining the basic morals and values of human life and moral upliftment. Books suitable for explaining basic moral and spiritual values of human life, academics instructions to school going children, containing simple science and short stories from epics depicting the life of ideal persons, sages and other renowned personalities of national and international fame to create awareness and promote human values and thus the human development.

ii. Books and journals on socio-economic issues and issues of public interest and within the legal framework and the provisions of the Constitution of India.

To provide information and organize awareness camps for eradication of social evils and disease by the help of expert teams of doctors, journalists, professionals, advocates and other learned persons.

To help poor and indigent person in the marriage of their disabled or needy sons and daughters in the form of cash and or kind.

(xxi) To award prizes in educational competition and to award scholarship for the needy and to provide ways and means for the upliftment of the poor and under-privileged children or individuals aiming to inculcate moral discipline.

(xxii) To arrange and provide educational and medical aid and such other assistance necessary for living, to the needy persons who are otherwise incapable or handicapped or mentally or physically retarded and financially uplift any person from the weaker section of the society.

(xxiii) To render any social, moral and financial assistance for the betterment of life of any unmarried girl or boy, widow or widower from time to time. To give monetary help to the disabled or blind persons in the form of monthly allowance or gratuities.

(xxiv) To provide for all activities for improving the moral standards of the people, promoting respect for all religion of tolerance and cordial feelings between different individuals irrespective of their caste, creed, colour, sex or religion.

(xxv) To start, establish, run, takeover or manage and maintain schools with an objective to provide sound pre-primary, middle, secondary, higher education and other institutions in typing, shorthand, computers, fine arts and crafts, music, painting, modeling, dancing, yoga, physical education and for other professional and technical training subjects and training subjects and discipline to make people self-employed and self-reliant by seeking recognitions from wherever required for the over all development of human resources of our social setup. This may include affiliation from the concerned Human Resource Departments and other concerned authorities.

(xxvi) To start, maintain and assist in relief measures in those parts which are or which become subjected to natural or man made calamities like famine, flood, fire, earthquake etc.

(xxvii) To meet traveling and boarding and lodging expenses for students going abroad for higher education and help them in all possible ways within the legal framework of The Constitution of India.

(xxviii) To approach and encourage people and organisation to donate and contribute moral, physical, technical, material and financial support for the needy mankind.

(xxix) To accept donations, grants, presents, gifts, raise subscriptions and any other offerings in the shape of movable and immovable properties for the attainment of the aims and objectives of the society and receive any financial and non-financial assistance from government, non-government organisation, international agencies, banks, members of the Trust and any other legal entity or other

individuals, societies, firms or companies, for providing income to the society on such terms and conditions as may be deemed proper and or necessary for the fulfillment of the aims and objects of the Trust and further its interests as enumerated above.

To engage, employ or hire appropriate staff, workers, legal experts and or professionals, attorneys, managers and agents for the working and furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Trust and to pay off their wages, salaries stipends or fees. However the members of the Governing Body may be appointed as a regular paid employee of this Trust as and when needed and as and when decided by the Governing Body.

(xxx) To purchase and or acquire land and or building in the name of the Trust and to erect, construct, alter, demolish, maintain, sell, lease, mortgage, transfer, improve, develop, manage and control all or any part of the building or assets and properties acquired or inherited or purchased, of the above Trust, necessary or convenient for the purpose of the attainment of the aims and objects of the Trust.


(xxxi) To undertake or adopt such things / acts / activities that are necessary and which may be incidental or conducive for the attainment of the all or any of the goals and objectives of the Trust.

(xxxii) The Trust could have its unit offices at any place in India and abroad. The activities and the units shall spread all over India and also abroad or can work with the legitimate Organisation or Organisations working world wide any where in the world.

(xxxiii) Those who are the members of the Governing Body for the purpose declares that the Founder of this Trust Dr. SAMINA RAHBARI will continue to be the Chief Executive Officer, the Secretary of the Trust and one of the members of the Governing Body for his life time.

(xxxiv) All activities shall be non profitable and shall be done on "No profit - No loss" basis.

(xxxv) All incomes, earnings movable / immovable properties of the Trust shall be solely utilised and applied towards the promotion of the

aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of this Trust and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of bonus, dividends, profit or in any manner whatsoever to the present and past members of the Trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or past members. No member of the Trust shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the Trust or make any profit, whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.

(xxxvi) Provided however, that any contribution by the trustees or the members of the Governing Body to or co-operation with any other Society or Trust or Projects having as its sole object in the form of all or any of the above mentioned objects shall mean furtherance of the goals and objectives of this Trust.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE TRUST

Name of the Trust: The name of the Trust shall be "NEW HORIZON EDUCATIONAL AND SCIENTIFIC ACCESS TRUST"

2. Membership:

The membership of the Trust is open to any person who has attained the age of maturity or twenty years irrespective of caste, creed, sex, colour, religion or nationality and fulfills the aims and objectives of the Trust and the terms and conditions of the Trust but subject to the Approval of the Governing body of the Trust.

The membership shall be of following categories:

- (a) **Founder:** The founder who is also the settlor of this Trust shall also be one of the trustees during her / his life time and after his death the eldest member of her own family shall be a co trustee.
- (b) **General Members:** A person who is admitted as General Member by the Governing Body and pays the requisite fee and the Monthly subscription fee as prescribed by the Governing Body from time to time shall become General Member of the society.
- (c) **Life Members:** Any person who is eligible to become member of the Trust will be enrolled as a Life Member on his / her payment of the required fee or any other amount fixed by the Governing Body from time to time.

 **Honorary Member:** The Governing Body may admit person/s as Honorary Member(s) who has / have rendered distinguished services in any area of Human Life and subscribe to the aims and objectives and the programmes of the Trust. The Honorary Members shall be entitled to attend meeting of the Trust. However, they have no right to vote or contest elections.

- (e) **Institutional Members:** The Governing Body may admit Govt./ Semi Govt. / Private Institutions as Institutional Members provided such Institutional subscribe to and / or involve in the implementations of such programmes as may be forwarded from time to time in accordance with the aims and objectives of the

Trust. Such institutions shall be required to pay such membership fee as prescribed by the Governing Body. Institutional Members can nominate and send one representative to the meeting of the Trust but shall have no right vote or contest elections.

3. Enrolment as members:

All applications for enrolment as members of the Trust shall be addressed to the Secretary of the Trust who after being satisfied about the genuineness of the contents of the applications shall submit the same before the Governing Body. The Governing Body after being satisfied may enroll such a person or institution as member of the Trust.

NOTE: if the Governing Body of the Trust does not approve the membership, the reason of the refusal shall be communicated to the person / applicants concerned and the decision of the Governing Body shall be the final.

4. Admission Fee & Subscription:

The admission fee and the subscription shall be as under unless otherwise revised by the Governing Body of the Trust:

Admission Fee:

Rs. 1000/= (One Thousand only for individuals)

Rs. 2000/= (Two Thousand only for organisations)


Subscription: Rs.125/= (One Hundred and Twenty five only) per month for all members.

Admission fees and monthly subscriptions may be changed, altered and fixed from time to time decided by the Governing Body of the Trust for all members.

5. Termination or Cessation of the membership:

The Governing Body of the Trust shall have the powers to expel / terminate a member or / member of the above Trust and on satisfaction of the Governing Body, on the following grounds:

On written resignation,

If found to be involved in any anti social activities,

If adjudged by any court of law to be a criminal offender,

If found guilty by means anti propaganda of the aims and object of the Trust,

If fails to pay the subscriptions or contribution for consecutive two months'

If has not attended two consecutive meetings,

If disregards rules and regulations or disobey the decisions of the Governing Body.

NOTE: The decision of the Governing Body regarding the termination from the membership of the Trust shall be communicated to the member concerned given seven days notice sent by Regd. Post to the member or to deliver to members by hand, and shall be provided reasonable opportunity to be heard, against whose membership is so sought to be removed from the Trust membership.

The decision of the Governing Body shall in all respect and cases be final.

6. Sources of Income:

(i) Admission Fee

(ii) Subscription

(iii) Donations and special contributions

(iv) Other legal sources and as per the provisions of the Law of land.

The income of the Trust received from all sources will be utilised only for the promotion of the aims and objectives of the Trust.

7. Audit of the Accounts:

(i) The auditor appointed by the Chairman on behalf of the Governing Body shall audit the accounts of the Trust annually. The Secretary in consultation with the Board shall place the Audit Report before the Governing Body.

(ii) The governing Body as per the prescribed law shall approve the financial year of the Trust.

Operation of the Bank Accounts:

(i) The Chairman or Vice - Chairman and the Secretary shall open an account in the name of :

"NEW HORIZON EDUCATIONAL AND SCIENTIFIC ACCESS TRUST"

(For the purpose of Banking Transaction the Names as "NEAT" OR "N.E.A.T" can also be used.)

9. Management of funds & Operations of Bank Accounts:

Joint signatures of the Chairman, Vice - Chairman and Secretary shall operate the bank accounts and the signature of the Secretary shall be one of the two signatures.

10. General Body Defined:

The General Body of the Trust shall consist of Life Members, General Members, Honorary Members of Trust.

NOTICE: Minimum 15 notice shall be given to the members, before the date of General Body meeting, enclosing agenda specifying date, time, place and issues to be discussed.


MEETING: General Body meeting shall be called upon as and when needed by the Governing Body to discuss the annual report and the Audit report.

The meeting shall be prescribed over by the Chairman and the members of the Governing Body and the agenda of the meeting shall be prepared by the Secretary with the consultation of the Governing Body.

11. Legal:

All legal Proceedings for or against the Trust shall be instituted in the name of the Trust through the Chairman and shall be subject to the jurisdiction where the registered office of the Trust situates. The Trust can also institute suits, actions and legal proceedings, to prefer appeals, to make applications or defend or compound, compromise, abandon, submit to arbitration or otherwise settle any suits, action, claim legal proceedings or appeals, demand or dispute relating to the Trust.

Rights & privileges of the members:

All and every member of the Trust :
Shall be entitled to participate in the meetings, cultural / educational functions and other lawful gatherings called or arranged by the Trust.
Have right to collect the identity card after depositing the required / pre-scribed fee (fixed by the Governing Body from time to time).

13. Duties of the members :

All and every member of the Trust shall:

Elect the Governing Body of the Trust,
Attend the General Body meetings regularly,
Give the necessary information to the society, pertaining to any matter, which is necessary to be known by the Trust.
Not indulge in activities that are prejudicial to the aims and objectives and or the rules and regulations of the Trust.

14. Governing Body:


Strength: The strength of the Governing Body (including office bearers and executive members) shall not be less than four and not more than twelve.

Terms: Term of every Governing Body shall be two years.

Notice: Minimum seven days notice shall be required for every Governing Body meeting of Trust but urgent meeting can be called by a twenty - four (24) hours notice.

Quorum: The quorum of every Governing Body meeting shall be held once in three months regularly (or as and the Governing Body of the Trust may decide from time to time).

Urgent Meeting: The urgent Governing Body meeting may be called by the twenty - four hours notice but quorum for the same urgent Governing Body meeting shall be $\frac{2}{3}$ rd of the total strength of the Governing Body of the Trust.

5. Functions & Powers of the Governing Body:

All following powers of the Governing Body shall be executed with the prior permission of the Founder in written.

The Governing Body shall consist of (1) Chairman, (2) Vice - Chairman (3) Joint Secretary (4) Secretary (5) Treasurer (6) Executive Members or any posts mentioned subject to a maximum limit of fourteen members including the five posts mentioned above and in no case shall be less than five.

The founder has the power to appoint the first Governing Body and thereafter all appointments of the members of the Governing Body shall be by the voting.

Governing Body shall be responsible for the management and administration of all affairs of the Trust and is also authorized to appoint any office bearer / executive members to look after any particular activity.

The Chairman shall preside over the meeting of the Trust and shall be competent to represent the Society in any condition.

The final authority shall be the Governing Body in all matters and decisions and all major decisions shall be taken by the majority votes including those of budget, accounts and audit. The Governing Body shall have the powers as mentioned in this deed and in these rules and regulations.

To prepare plans, projects and programmes and to appoint and or delegate its power to any such committee, officer, or institution by a specific resolution. It can also appoint election officer or officers and allocate his or her or their powers.

16. Composition of the Governing Body:

The composition of the Governing Body shall be as under.

- (a) Chairman / Chairperson:
- (b) Vice - Chairman / Chairperson
- (c) Secretary
- (d) Joint Secretary
- (e) Treasurer
- (f) Executive Members

Powers and Duties of the Office Bearers:

(A) Chairman / Chairperson


- (a) Chairman shall preside over all the meetings of the Trust.
- (b) At the time of voting on any matter / subject (except) election, if the total votes of the group of members happen to be equal in number, the Chairman has the power to cast an extra vote to decide the matter / subject.
- (c) Chairman shall have the power to allow inclusion of any subject /matter in the agenda for the discussion in the course of proceedings / meetings.
- (d) Chairman will sign all the papers / letters, on behalf of the Society, to conduct its correspondence or on behalf of the Chairman the person so authorised by the Governing Body.
- (e) The Chairman shall be appointed on rotation basis after the expiry of his / or her term in office for two years. He / she also can be appointed again if the majority votes.

(B) Vice - Chairman / Chairperson:

The Vice - Chairman of the Trust shall enjoy all the powers of the Chairman in his /or her absence.

(C) Secretary:

- (a) Secretary will summon and attend the meetings of the Governing Body and General Body. He or she will be in-charge of the office work and maintain the records of the office of the Trust.
- (b) Secretary will prepare the membership register as well as the proceedings register to record the minutes of the proceedings of the governing body meetings and the general Body meetings and to have them duly signed by the members who attend the meetings.
- (c) The Secretary shall be responsible to prepare the Annual report of the Trust under the Guidance of the Governing Body and present the same in the meetings of the Governing Body.
- (d) The Secretary shall be appointed by the majority vote of the members of the Governing Body and the tenure can be extended

further if the majority of the members of the Governing Body decide.

(e) He / She shall be responsible to manage the bank accounts and sign the cheques or other banking papers along with the Chairman or Vice-Chairman or as per the provisions of this deed of Trust.

(D) Treasurer:


(a) All funds of the Trust shall remain under the management of the treasurer or the person duly appointed by the governing body.

(b) The treasurer shall maintain the accounts of all the money that is received and or paid by him or her in cash or in any other form on behalf of the Trust.

(c) The treasurer shall make disbursement in accordance with the direction of the governing Body.

18. Re-Admission:

In case, the Governing Body expels any member of the Trust on the reason of non-payment of the subscription he or she can be re-admitted, provided the member concerned pays up all the dues up to date with permission of the Governing Body. In any other case of re-admission the decision of the Governing Body shall be the final.

19. Appeals:

All appeals shall be preferred to the Governing Body of the Trust and the decision of the Governing Body shall be the final.

20. Filling up of casual vacancy:

Any casual vacancy amongst the Governing body shall be filled by the resolution passed by the governing Body in its coming meeting. The Governing Body shall have the power to create various posts and appoint the staff of the society on such terms and conditions as decided by the Governing Body.

Financial Year:

The financial Year of the Trust shall start from 1st April and ending on 31st march every year.

22. Dissolution:

If the Trust needs to be dissolved, if their remains after the satisfaction of the debts and liabilities in movable and immovable property or properties the same shall not be paid or distributed among members but shall be transferred to some other association Society or Trust to be determined by the Governing Body which shall have the similar aims and objectives similar to this Trust. Founder may dissolve the Governing Body if it is found that the Governing Body is not working in the interest of the Trust and can form a new Governing Body.

23. Amendments:


All or any amendments to the Rules and Regulations (by-laws) of the Trust shall be made by the Chairman after the approval of the Governing Body.

24. General:

(i) The property of the Trust whether movable or immovable shall be vested in the Governing Body of the Trust.

(ii) The Founder may shall have the power to dissolve the Governing Body and constitute new Governing Body when she thinks fit that the governing body is working against the objectives of the Trust.

(iii) The number of offices bearers and members of the Governing Body may be increased or decreased by the majority voting in the meeting of the Governing body.

(iv) The Governing Body shall have the power to frame the by-laws of the Trust for the management of its day to day affairs and the conditions of the employees of the Trust or in respect of any Committee / institutions setup by this Trust in the promotion of the aims and objects of this Trust.

(v) The Governing body shall be competent to open and run branches offices or to establish institution in India and abroad for and on behalf of the Trust.

(vi) The Governing Body shall have the power to affiliate the Trust with other Association / Society / Trust on such terms and conditions as it may deem fit and proper keeping in view the Law of the Land and the aims and objects of the Trust.

(vii) Any member of the Trust or the Governing Body or office bearer may resign at any time from the day of the office held by him or her writing addressing to the Chairman / Secretary. The resignation of any member shall become effective from the date / day of its acceptance by the Chairman or the Secretary.

(viii) To appoint, nominate and constitute attorney(s), legal practioners agents etc. and delegate their duties with regard to management of the Trust stating, including and or defending of the legal proceeding(s) and other related matters.

(ix) The Governing body may from time to time frame, change and alter the Rules and Regulations as per the requirements of the time and need of the hour and changing Government Laws. In the absence of any such rules or applicable rules and by-laws for the Trust :

- a. All matters will be decided by majority of the members of the Governing Body by a Two-third majority.




