In accordance with national educational goals & NEP 2020, the school shall promote national and emotional integration by broadening the mental outlook of the students, fostering in them courage, compassion, truth, tolerance, and a spirit of pride and patriotism.

The school lays particular emphasis on discipline which is indispensable to build a sound personality. To keep a high standard of academic atmosphere, the school instills in the students the values of good manners, punctuality, cleanliness and a strong sense of responsibility.

With a very dedicated team of teachers, their countless efforts with a child centric approach to teaching, our students have performed par excellence, both in academic and non-academic domains. In the academic domain our students are pursuing their B.Tech degrees from IIT colleges. THE CURRICULUM

The school follows the CBSE curriculum. English is the medium of instruction and examination at all levels. However, Sanskrit, Urdu and Hindi occupy the same importance. Besides English, Mathematics, General Science, Social Science are also taught. Character building and the development of spiritual values are also emphasized. Lessons are regularly given to students through Moral Science, Computer Science; Quizzes, Games, Assignments, Nature Studies & Project are additional efforts to develop students' talents. The school strictly follows the NSQF pattern as it is affiliated with CBSE, New Delhi up to senior secondary level.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE

1. **Smart Classrooms** : Equipped with modern technology to enhance learning.
2. **Library** : A well-furnished library with a wide range of books and resources.
3. **Science Laboratories** : Fully equipped laboratories for hands-on experiments and learning.
4. **Language Lab** : Well-equipped language lab to improve language skills.
5. **Games & Sports** : Provision for both indoor and outdoor games and sports activities.
6. **CCTV Surveillance** : 24*7 monitoring through CCTV cameras.
7. **Hostel** :
 - Available for boys and girls from Std. III onwards.
 - Single bed facility.
 - Hygienic environment with nutritious food.

ADMISSION

1. Children are usually admitted only into Pre-Nur. and Nursery. Although a few children may be admitted to other classes only if casual vacancies occur.
2. Those parents who seek admission of their ward in school are required to fill up the admission form available in the school office.
3. Admission is made strictly on the basis of merit by written Test / Interview / Scholarship.
4. Required Documents: -
 - Birth Certificate (issued by competent authority)/Aadhaar Card.
 - Transfer/Migration Certificate (Wherever Applicable), Mark Sheet (Previous Class)
 - Medical Fitness Certificate & Blood Group (From a registered MBBS Doctor).
 - Family Photograph.
 - Passport size photographs.
 - Fee has to be deposited within seven days of selection, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next waiting candidate.

EXAMINATION & PERFORMANCE

1. The school conducts four examinations, including Half-Yearly and Annual, in each academic session.
2. Promotions are given on the basis of entire year's performance. Every student must be present for the terminal exams. Marks secured in the annual examinations are not the only criteria for promotion.
3. As per precondition for promotion, every student is required to be present for 80% of the total academic days in the year.
4. In order to get promoted, students are required to score 40% marks in all subjects. Passing in both language and Mathematics is compulsory.
5. There shall be neither re-tests nor re-exams. If a student does not pass in all subjects, any concession he/she avails will be cancelled.
6. The result declared at the end of the session is final and cannot be reconsidered.
7. All the rights regarding promotion or failure are vested in the Principal and her decision will be final.

SESSION

The school session is April to March.

WITHDRAWALS

1. Withdrawal from any class must be proceeded by one month's notice in writing or one month's fee in lieu thereof.
2. All dues must be cleared before a Transfer Certificate is issued.
3. The Transfer Certificate will be issued one week after receiving the application.
4. School authorities may ask the parents, without prior notice, to withdraw the children from the school on any of the following grounds :
 - Academic : Constant weakness in studies or failure in the same class for two consecutive sessions.
 - Disciplinary : Students whose conduct, in the opinion of the Principal, is harmful to the interests of the institution.
 - Fee Arrear : Non-Payment of fees for three consecutive months.

THE SCHOOL UNIFORM

1. All pupils should come to the school neat and tidy, dressed in the school uniform which is as follows :
 - Monday to Wednesday : Coloured Uniform.
 - Thursday & Friday : White Uniform.
 - Saturday : House Uniform.
2. Students are required to attend all school functions/activities, and Parent - Teacher Meetings (PTM) inside or outside the school, in school uniform only.

Note : Students must wear winter uniform as prescribed by the school.
